

## VILLA ZURICH

GO INTERIORS ZURICH, SWITZERLAND

Go Interiors was the interior design company commissioned to design the entire interior concept, including this spa, in a villa built by Meier Architekten. The country house-style three-story villa demonstrates both classic and modern elements in the spa area, displaying a striking elegance perfectly suited to this cozy private space. Access to the spa is provided via an entrance area illuminated by a decorative lighting element. This tranquil oasis offers views across the garden and the lake that lies adjacent to the villa. Chains of glass spheres not only serve as a striking decorative element, they also diffract the artificial light.

A tunnel leads into the spa area, where a piece of furniture with a copper basin is located, designed by the client himself. To the right of this, the room opens out to the sauna and wellness shower, and to the left the steam bath and toilets. The rooms are darker in this area and artificial lights have been cleverly integrated to create the perfect atmosphere and make the haptic of the surfaces more tangible.










## VILLA RAPPERSWIL

Different atmospheres have been developed throughout the property; such as a stylish and warm guest bathroom and the elegant and generously proportioned master bathroom. A modern training and wellness area boasts direct access to the interior courtyard.
